It was a surreal experience walking through one of Africa's largest airports in complete darkness (even the auxiliary power generators failed) with nothing but the tiny light of our cell phone to shine the way.

We were reminded of the song we learned as children: "This little light of mine, I'm gonna let it shine ..." A powerful reminder that the smallest light dispels darkness. After a hour waiting in line at Customs, the power eventually came back and we made our way to our guest house.


"In him was life, and that life was the light of men. That light shines in the darkness, and yet the darkness did not overcome it." -- John 1:4-5 (CSB)

Beautiful Africa!

Africa is an amazing continent! We have already traveled to 16 of her 57 countries. We have witnessed the rugged coast of South Africa where the Atlantic, Indian and Antarctic Oceans collide. We've been to Lake Victoria and the headwaters of the Nile River in Uganda, and a few weeks ago our flight took us past Mount Kilimanjaro. Africa is a beautiful continent!

However, the real beauty lies in the African people themselves, totaling 1.5 Billion, from over 2,500 ethnic groups, speaking 2,110 different languages!



We have made six trips into Africa in the past few years, ministering in 16 nations. This trip was the most exciting so far! We began holding a week long

> leadership conference in Kitale, Kenya, near the beautiful 14,000 ft. Mount Elgon, near the Ugandan border. This area is the "bread basket" of the nation with rich farm land.

> Sound Biblical teaching and training continues to be a huge need for African pastors, most of which have little or no training at all! Over 70 leaders from several area churches came each day. We taught on Leadership, Lovina Jesus. Evangelism and Stewardship. On the final two days we held a marriage seminar, complete with a marriage ceremony, where twelve couple renewed their vows! One pastor spoke for the rest, when he said, "We have failed our congregations by never speaking on sex and marriage. We've let the Culture train our children. No

more!" Another pastor said, "My marriage is forever changed!" Praise the LORD!





From Kenya we flew to Dar es Salaam, on the coast of Tanzania. Although our stay was a brief overnighter to make a connecting flight, we shared Jesus with over 20 people. Pray for Isaac, our young Muslim taxi driver, who got a clear presentation of the Gospel. He's close to giving his life to Jesus!

From Dar es Salaam, we flew to Blantyre, Malawi, our 129th nation!

"Satan has often exercised total dominion over the [African] people through sickness, drought, insanity, and the many bondages of fear, superstition, and idolatry. When I preach the gospel I can feel these curses break. The light of the gospel shines into the darkness and overcomes it." - Reinhard Bonnke

We have an interesting personal connection with Malawi that goes back over 25 years. At the time I was working for a ministry involved in politics, and was in Washington DC for meetings with Christian leaders, among them, then U.S. Senator (and future US Attorney General under President George W. Bush) John Ashcroft. I met in Senator Aschroft's office early one morning to attend a Bible study which he lead with his staff. At the time, I recall, he sat on a Senate sub-committee on Africa. A large map of the continent was on the Senator's wall. During each morning Bible study, a few moments were set aside to pray for a specific country. That morning, the country was Malawi!

Arriving in Malawi 25 years later to train young people was, in a way, coming full-circle. We taught for the week at the Youth With a Mission (YWAM)
