Need a Miracle? Here's How to Get It!



“Faith is like an empty, open hand stretched out towards God, with nothing to offer and everything to receive.” -- John Calvin

It's one of the great miracles of the Gospels, found in Mark 5:21-34. A woman who had suffered from continuous bleeding for twelve years, spending all of her money on doctors, yet only getting worse. Having heard the stories of Jesus' countless miracles, she presses through the crowd to touch Him. And she was instantly healed!

You may be facing a seemingly insurmountable battle with pain, sickness or disease. Maybe you've seen many doctors, with negative reports, just like the woman in Mark 5, only to get worse.

Do you need a miracle today? The woman with the bleeding released her faith and got the healing she desperately needed. Do what she did.

First, **Speak Faith!** She agreed with God's Word! Mark 5:27-28 says, *“When she heard about Jesus' healing power, she pushed through the crowd and came up from behind him and touched his prayer shawl. For she kept saying to herself, ‘If only I could touch His clothes, I know I will be healed.’” (TPT)*

What are you saying when you're needing a miracle? Are you speaking words of doubt and unbelief or are you declaring what God says about your situation! The words you speak reflect what you Believe!

Jesus said: *“Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours.”* Mark 11:24 (AMPC)

Second, **Act on your Faith!** When she heard, she pushed through the crowd and reached out and

touched the corner of Jesus' prayer shawl.

She knew what she was touching. The blue tassel in the corner of a prayer shawl represented the owner's authority!

She heard the stories of Jesus' miracle working power! She told herself over and over that if she could just touch Him she knew she'd be healed! The fact that she was ritually unclean and that there was a huge crowd around Jesus, didn't intimidate her! She pressed in and grabbed hold of the very symbol of His authority!

*“A faith that does not do things is a dead faith.”
James 2:17 (NLV)*

What is the Miracle that you need? Because Faith's Confession requires Action! Persevere! Press in! Never give up!

Third, **Receive your Miracle by Faith!** That means to keep believing and thanking God until it is manifested in your life!

The woman with the issue of blood *heard* the stories about Jesus. She *believed* those stories. She went to Jesus, pushed through, reached out, and took her healing!

You may be thinking, *“Yeah, but I tried that once and it didn't work!”* Keep declaring! “Lord I thank You that by Your stripes I was healed. I receive my Healing now (it's MINE!) and I thank You for it in Jesus' Name!”

We are living in tough times! The only way you're going to survive is by reading the Word, meditating on the Word, speaking the Word and Standing on it! God's Word, the Bible, needs to be more real to you than what you see or feel!

Fourth, **Share your Testimony of Faith!** Mark 5:33-34 says: *“When the woman who experienced this miracle realized what had happened to her, she came before him, trembling with fear, and threw herself down at his feet, saying, ‘I was the one who touched you.’ And she told him her story of what had just happened.” (TPT)*

“You have faith stories too. No matter how small, remember them, recite them, count them, and celebrate them. They build your faith for what is coming next in your life.” – Reinhard Bonnke

Now Speak Faith! Act on your Faith! Receive your Miracle by Faith! Share your Testimony of Faith!

Paper Preachers

“The Kingdom of God is like a farmer who scatters seed on the ground. Night and day ... the seed sprouts and grows, but he does not understand how it happens. And as soon as the grain is ready, the farmer comes and harvests it with a sickle, for the harvest time has come.”

I remember, as if it were yesterday, the very first time I passed out Gospel tracts. I was a new Believer, barely 17 years old, and scared! As my friend and I walked through the trailer park in Lake Elmo, Minnesota, we silently prayed that nobody would be home. At the very first trailer we were greeted by a young man who welcomed us in. His living room was filled with religious items revealing that he was on a search for God! Though he didn't give his life to Christ that evening, I do remember, in my trembling nervousness, reading to him the “Four Spiritual Laws” and praying with him. We left feeling defeated and vowing never to do *that* again. But, I look back and see that it was not only a divine appointment for that man, but it was a turning point in my own life!

Fast forward 43 years! On January 24, in Leutersdorf, Germany, we reached a milestone, 400,000 pieces of Gospel literature (“seeds”) sown in 129 nations!

We have met many Christians over the years with the opinion that passing out Gospel tracts doesn't work. Our experience proves otherwise. We have seen countless people come to faith in Jesus using these “paper preachers.” We have encountered many people on the streets who have told us that that very day they were planning to commit suicide! One woman in Brazil said, “As you handed me this paper, I felt Jesus reaching out and touching me!” A woman in Latvia said, “How did you know I needed to hear this today!” Another, in Belize, said “I want Jesus now!”

The reason Gospel tracts are a great way to reach people is because God's Word always produces a harvest (Is 55:11)! So don't be ashamed to tell people the good news. It is the only message that can heal and transform the human heart (Rom 1:16)

Just a Word

One encouraging word can change a life forever! That's especially true for a young child! We recently had the honor of speaking to groups of eager, rambunctious kindergarteners about Africa. They loved it, and we were touched as each responded by praying for the children of Africa!
