The Man in White

Muslims are coming to faith in Jesus in record numbers all around the world, through radio, internet, literature, and dreams / visions of "the Man in White," which is why now is the time to place maximum effort in getting the Gospel to them!

A recent study in Germany reported that of the over 5 million Muslims who have immigrated to Germany

in recent years, 20 percent are leaning towards radicalism. Pray with us that the veil of deception will be lifted from their eyes, and a true spiritual hunger will lead them to Jesus "The Man in White".

We have passed out over 185,000 pieces of Gospel literature to every home in 218 German towns and villages so far. Thousands of Muslim homes have received the Good News. We declare that God's Word, like seed planted in the ground, will bare much fruit! (Isaiah 55:11)

Greenland

Greenland is a dream come true! Our countless flights across the Atlantic, between the USA and Europe, would usually bring us directly over, or near, the southern tip of this massive snow-covered island. I had silently hoped that during one of those flights there would be a need for an unscheduled landing so



we could pray minister, and even in a small way, on the island! Well. the LORD, in His wonderful timing, has opened now the door to preach the Gospel there!

About the time you receive this newsletter, I will be landing in the capitol city of Nuuk (pop 20,000), to teach in several meetings, training youth and adults, and concluding with a marriage seminar.

This remote and sparsely populated island nation (total pop 56,000), has been getting a lot of attention in the news for its wealth of natural resources and strategic location.



In a way, coming to Greenland, is coming full-circle for our family. Kathy's grandfather, Elzie Gillen.

was a crane operator during World War II and helped build strategic airbases for the USA in Greenland, that would protect troop ships to and from Europe, saving countless American lives!

The impact of the Gospel in Greenland began over 1,000 years ago, when the Norse explorer, Erik the Red, came to established a settlement. His wife, Thjodhild, had accepted Jesus Christ and established the first church there.

Hans Egede, a Lutheran missionary, arrived in Greenland in 1722, and after several years of ministry, had only a handful of converts and a lot of opposition from the local Inuit peoples. In 1733 three Moravian missionaries from Herrnhut, Germany arrived. While translating the Gospel of Matthew, the locals were captivated by the story of Jesus' suffering and death on the Cross. Soon, many were coming to faith in Jesus. The story of God's Son, coming as a spotless lamb to be the perfect sacrifice for their sins, would forever change the course of history for Greenland.

Though 95% of the Greenlanders identify as Lutherans, spiritism is practiced widely. Pray right now, that this current generation of 56,000 Greenlandic people will experience a new spiritual awakening and transformational encounter with the Living God!

Madagascar

We are so excited about an opportunity to fly to Madagascar in July to train young leaders at the

YWAM Land of Canaan base in the capitol city of Antananarivo. It is always a huge honor to pour into the lives of young people who have a passion to impact their nation with the Gospel.



It has a population of over

30 million, with 90% living on less than \$4 per day! Madagascar is special in that 90% of the animals and plant life cannot be found anywhere else on Earth! Christianity came to this second largest island nation, first through Portuguese, and then, French, colonialists. Though over half the people identify as Christians, Spiritism and tribal religions are widespread.

Pray for the much-needed training of leaders, discipleship of Believers, and outpouring of the Holy Spirit, so that they can more effectively take the Gospel to the 10 remaining unreached people groups on the island.
