Anywhere With JESUS



"Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles, and let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us." (Heb 12:1, NIV)

Do you know what your God given assignment is? Jesus said: *"Go into all the World and preach the good news to everyone."* (Mk 6:15, NLT) Yes, that's our assignment, to go to all the nations and share the simple message, that there is a God who loves you and wants to have a relationship with you.

God has a marked-out journey for all of us ... a race we are called to run. But we have a choice to either get in the race or opt out. I (Kathryn) almost missed out on God's adventurous journey for my life, because of a crippling fear of traveling by air.

What is hindering you from the race marked out for your life? Fear of the unknown? Insecurities? Pride?

Take it from me, or better yet, from the Word of God, that you can fully trust the One who died for you! You can trust His leadership over your life. He created you! He's not just a shepherd, He is the Good Shepherd! He knows what He's doing! But He needs your willingness, your cooperation, your complete surrender, for you to finish this race well!

It was the kindness and gentleness of the LORD who met me where I was. He delivered me and "set me free from all my fears." (Ps 34:4)

One day I received a vision from the Lord. I was not sleeping, but my eyes were closed. I was standing in a doorway looking out into a courtyard surrounded by a white stone wall with rose vines hanging over the sides. The Lord spoke to my heart, *"Kathy, come and smell the roses."*

I knew it was Israel! Instantly my heart changed with an intense desire to go there.

Our first overseas mission trip was Israel in 1999. It would prove to be a prophetic act in our assignment to take the Gospel to every nation. God says in Ezekial 5:5, that He has set Jerusalem in the center of the nations. So, it made sense that this would be the first of what has become our ministry to 134 nations, so far!

Yes, I went and I smelled the roses. That was just the beginning of multiple adventures the Lord has brought us on.

What are you waiting for? What is holding you back from the God given assignment for you? Don't let anything hinder you from the race marked out for you. Never forget: It's worth it serving JESUS!

"Do Your Best to Come To Me Quickly"

These are among the final words written by Paul the Apostle. Paul knew that his assignment on earth was coming to a close, so he writes this, his final letter, to Timothy, his "son in the faith."

During Paul's previous visit to Rome, he had been under house arrest, awaiting an audience with Emperor Nero (Acts 28). Following his release in AD 62 he traveled on his fourth missionary journey, during which time he wrote the *Pastoral Letters* of 1 Timothy and Titus. But now, times are much different. Persecution against Christians has intensified, and Paul is in a cold dungeon, chained like a criminal.

"At my first defense, no one came to my support, but everyone deserted me ... But the Lord stood at my side and gave me strength." (2 Tim 4:16-17, NIV)

Paul is sharing a deep pain that was the result of human loneliness. In our 35 years of full-time ministry (20 of which have been overseas), we have seen how missionaries struggle with, among other things, loneliness. Living cross-culturally is exciting at times, but also taxing both physically and emotionally.

While living in communist China 20 years ago, Kathryn and I experienced a season of severe pressure and loneliness. Like Paul, we despaired of life itself. (2 Cor 1:8) It was while we were in this pit of discouragement that we met a couple whose


ministry it is to counsel missionaries. With compassion they listened, counseled, and pointed us on a path towards healing and finishing our assignment in China with Victory! Their counsel has stayed with us these past 20 years!

This is why we are so excited to share with you that we have enrolled in the Youth With a Mission (YWAM) **Member Care Foundations Course**. It involves three months of intensive training (February – May) with onsite module teaching at YWAM bases in Heidebeek, Netherlands (*photo below*); Herrnhut, Germany; and Glasgow, Scotland.



We are being equipped with valuable tools to help us bring compassion, healing and restoration to other missionaries around the world! The training is a lot of information to consume, but we know that from our own experience, it's worth it!

Jesus Loves Africa!



One of the reasons Kathryn's mother didn't want us to get married 43 years ago, was her fear that we would be missionaries to Africa. She knew that we were sold-out for Jesus and were willing to follow Him to the ends of the earth. Well, she was right! Since then, we have had the privilege to minister, so far, in 21 African nations!

It is a continent made up of 54 nations, 1.5 billion people, from over 3,000 different ethnic groups!

We are excited to be making several trips into Africa this year! In April we'll be teaching at YWAM bases in **Burundi** and **Zambia**!

Burundi is a small country (the size of Hawaii) with a population of 14 million, but it is strategically situated in the heart of Africa. The current stability of the nation is threatened by rebel groups operating across the border in the DRC, causing a massive influx of refugees. Also, ethnic violence in the 1990s caused the deaths of over 300,000 people.

We will have the privilege of training young missionary leaders at the YWAM base in the capitol city of Bujumbura



on the important topics of: dating, courtship, marriage, and parenting. Because most African churches have failed to teach on these important topics from a Biblical worldview, sexual immorality and broken families are the result. Pray!

Then we will fly to Lusaka, the capitol of **Zambia**. Although most of the 22 million Zambians identify as being Christian, few are trained in the Word of God and live a life of victory. Carnality, superstitions and occult practices are common.



Young people under the age of 15, make up 44% of the population, and need to encounter the transformational power of Jesus and be discipled. This is why we are coming! We will be teaching at YWAM Lusaka on the topics of: Biblical Leadership, Making Jesus LORD, and The Father Heart of God. We will also be hosting a Marriage Seminar for the community. Whew! Busy, but exciting! The need in Africa is so great!

Partnership is the Key

We thank God for our partners and pray for them every day! Because it is through their faithful giving that we are able to "run the race" and take the Gospel around the world. In this newsletter you read about two exciting Kingdom-Building opportunities. The **YWAM Member Care training** will enable us to help missionaries run the race and finish well. The total cost is about \$2,000. Our flights in April from Germany to **Burundi and Zambia** will cost about \$4,000.
